Although not considering himself an impersonator, Mr. Snow has been compared to Frank Sinatra by his audiences, due to his manner, voice inflection, and his hat and tuxedo- hence the nickname-The Cincinnati Sinatra; He also sings mostly the music of Sinatra, although many of his performances have also included songs more closely associated with Bing Crosby, Dean Martin, Sammy Davis, Jr., Andy Williams, Nat King Cole and Bobby Darin.

"The Ultimate Sinatra Tribute", his signature show, consists of four sets, covering the six-plus decades of Frank Sinatra's career:"The Early Years"-Hits of the 30's and 40's;"The Comeback Years"-The 50's Era;"The Very Good Years"-The Songs of the 60's, and "The Final Curtain"-the period after Sinatra's brief Retirement, which covers the 70's, 80's and 90's.

The Snow Family has enjoyed visiting the French Lick area many times over the years, and with a successful engagement this fall, Mr. Snow says he would "love to make a regular trek to these parts if the local folks will support a show like mine."
